



The population of the world (2009)

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Every other year, the summer issue of *Population & Societies* called *The population of the world* presents a global picture of the world population. The data shown here can be found in the *World Population Data Sheet* published by the Population Reference Bureau (PRB) (1) [1].

The data shown in the central data sheet concern all geopolitical entities with a population of 150,000 or more and a few others. Sovereign states are listed along with non-sovereign territories, including France's overseas départements. Countries and territorial entities are listed following the United Nations system of classification by region and continent.

The demographic indicators are practically all the same as those used in earlier editions: land area, mid-2009 population estimate, birth and death rates, infant mortality rate, total fertility rate, percentage of population under 15 and over 65, male and female life expectancy at birth, gross national income per capita adjusted for purchasing power parity (GNI PPP) in 2008, proportion of persons with HIV/AIDS among the adult population aged 15 to 49 at the end of 2007 (these figures include persons with full-blown AIDS as well as those infected by the virus who are not yet ill). In this 2009 edition, the fifth column gives the population projections for 2050 (rather than 2025 as previously). Note that the other indicators are also projections, but over a short period, as vital statistics and survey data are not yet available for the year 2009.

Eighteen smaller tables classify countries or geopolitical entities according to different indicators, following a downward scale. In the first eight tables,

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countries are listed by world ranking. A world total is given and a line separates the countries totalling more than half of the world figure. For instance, the six most populated countries (China, India, United States, Indonesia, Brazil, Pakistan) represent a total population of 3.42 billion, or more than half of the world population, estimated at 6.81 billion. Tables 9 to 18 show a representative selection of countries (their world ranking is indicated in the left-hand column). In the seventeenth and penultimate small table, countries are classified according to the proportion of working-age persons aged 15-64 in the total population. This proportion is especially high in the small Persian Gulf states, which have large populations of immigrant workers living without their families, and in countries where fertility has fallen sharply to very low levels, not only in the developed world (Russia, Poland), but also in the South (China, South Korea, Tunisia). The population pyramids of these Southern countries now have a narrow base, while their summit is still very small. Their shape will change, however, as the proportion of persons aged 15-64 decreases due to population ageing.
